

## Objectives

## History

In 1989, Gary Tinker, a resident of Pinehouse with cerebral palsy completed a 650-kilometer walk on crutches from La Ronge to Regina. Gary undertook this walk to raise awareness of the needs of people with disabilities in northern Saskatchewan. In November of 1989, a steering committee was set up, which included representatives from Northern Affairs Secretariat, Saskatchewan Education Training and Employment and Human Resources Development Canada. These agencies along with Gary Tinker and other concerned persons and representatives from the disabled community established the Gary Tinker Federation for the Disabled Inc.
